A meeting of the Plymouth School Committee was held on Monday, October 2, 2006, at Plymouth North High School at 6:30 p.m.

Discussion was held regarding five Resolutions proposed by the Resolutions Committee of the Massachusetts Association of School Committees to be voted on at its Annual Business Meeting by the Voting Delegate from the Plymouth School Committee.

Motion was made by Mrs. Freedman, seconded by Mrs. Manfredi, to direct the Voting Delegate to vote "yes" on Resolution 1 on the first ballot. On a roll call vote, all in favor, approved unanimously.

Motion was made by Mrs. Freedman, seconded by Mr. Begley, to direct the Voting Delegate to vote "yes" on Resolution 2 on the first ballot. On a roll call vote, all in favor, approved unanimously.

Motion was made by Mrs. Freedman, seconded by Mrs. Adelman, to direct the Voting Delegate to vote "yes" on Resolution 3 on the first ballot. On a roll call vote, all in favor, approved unanimously.

Motion was made by Mrs. Freedman, seconded by Mrs. Manfredi, to direct the Voting Delegate to vote "yes" on Resolution 4 on the first ballot. On a roll call vote, all in favor, approved unanimously.

Motion was made by Mrs. Adelman, seconded by Mr. Begley, to direct the Voting Delegate to vote "yes" on Resolution 4 on the first ballot. On a roll call vote, Mrs. Adelman, Mr. White and Mr. Begley voted in favor. Mrs. Manfredi and Mrs. Freedman voted against. Mrs. Freedman said that this might reward districts that do not budget well. Motion carries.

Motion by Mrs. Freedman, seconded by Mr. Begley, to adjourn meeting.
